  - b) The manner in which Stream-I Project proposals are being proposed i.e., whether these originate from the Departments, the Districts or some other institutions;
  - c) The break-up of the Stream-I projects into sub-sector like Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy, Fisheries, Soil and Water Conservation etc.;
  - d) Updated financial and physical performance, project-wise under Stream-I of the RKVY during 2007-08; and
  - e) Which are the project/schemes that have been strengthened with Stream-II funds of RKVY during 2007-08?

5. In addition, the Deputy Chairman would like to also have a detailed picture on the various aspects of the seed farms, and how these farms are being utilized. This should include information on the farms under the SAUs, ICAR and Central Organizations like NSC/SFCI etc. besides the States' own farms.

6. It is requested to kindly furnish the above mentioned information and details of the team latest by 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2008.
