Description of content : <p>The Draft Plant Quarantine (Regulation of Import into India) (Sixth Amendment) Order, 2009 seeks to further liberalize provisions governing import of 12 items notified under Schedule VI, for various countries. Out of the 12 items, 7 are plants/cuttings for propagation, 1 is seeds for sowing, 1 is fruits for consumption, 1 is logs with and without bark, 1 is Tissue culture plants and 1 is Palm kernel for consumption. There are 34 items (SI. No. 678 – 711) which have been added under Schedule VI of the Order for the first time. This notification will make possible imports of plants and plant materials into India, which were, hitherto, not permitted to be imported into India.
