
Subject:- Notification regarding Plant Quarantine (Regulation of Import into India) (Fourth Amendment) Order, 2008, to be made in the SPS Committee of WTO.

Please find enclosed the text of the notification to the WTO containing the draft Plant Quarantine (Regulation of Import into India) (Fourth Amendment) Order, 2008 proposing certain amendments to the phytosanitary conditions governing the import of certain plants and plant materials into India.

Description of content : The Draft Plant Quarantine (Regulation of Import into India) (Fourth Amendment) Order, 2008 seeks to further liberalize provisions governing import of 17 items notified under Schedule VI, for various countries. Out of the 17 items, 4 are plants for propagation, 10 are seeds for sowing, 1 is fruit for consumption, 1 is wood with/ without bark and 1 is tissue culture plant. There are 13 items (Sl. No. 629 – 641) which have been added under Schedule VI of the Order for the first time. This notification will make possible imports of plants and plant materials into India, which were, hitherto, not permitted to be imported into India.
